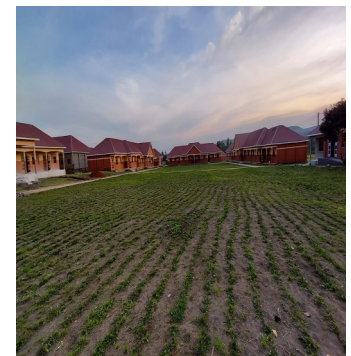
Rejoice with us! Sponsors, Prayer Team, and Donors,
